

"THE LIVING TABLEAU" TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS INTERIOR SCREENING

Screen

- High contrast, gain 0.7-1.0
 - Eg. micro-perforated grey projection surface stretched on bilight EX290 structure
- 2:1 ratio
 - Preferred size 8x4 meters, depending on the room
 - At least 1 meter from walls on either side
 - At least 80 cm above floor

Projector

- Laser phosphor projector
- UHD / 4K (native or wobbled)
- Preferably 3-Chip DLP
- 100% Rec. 709, or wider, gamut coverage
- HDMI 2.0 or 6G-SDI connection
- Placed on structure or fixed to ceiling
- Approved models:
 - Recommended: Panasonic PT-RQ13K with 12G-SDI connection
 - Alternatives: Barco F80-4K12 or Barco F90-4K13
 - \circ Any other projector is to be approved by the AFA technical advisor / advisors.
- Calibration:
 - The projector is to be pre-calibrated by the AV rental company
 - \circ Final calibration is to be performed by the AFA technical advisor / advisors.

Audio

- Stereo
- Full-range speaker system
- Mixing console
- Connection to media player: 2x ¹/₄ inch audio jack
- To cover the whole room
- Music is an integral part of the 'Tableau' and therefore high quality audio is essential.
- Final approval of sound by AFA technical advisor / advisors

Media Player

- The media player will be provided by AFA, containing the video file.
- Preprogrammed for playback
- iPad remote control option (iPad not provided)
- Power supply: 100 240V AC
- Ideal distance between media player and projector: less than 5 meters
- AFA will prepare and color grade the 'Tableau' media file to be compatible with the specific projector used.

Installation Supervision

The screen, projector and audio equipment, as well as the installation and construction costs, are to be sourced and determined locally and are the responsibility of the exhibitor. The video file and the media player are proprietary elements and will be provided by AFA. The AFA technical advisor / advisors will deliver the media player and file at an agreed upon schedule prior to the opening and will approve and calibrate the final image and sound.

The AFA curator and technical advisors will be in communication with the exhibitor and, as needed, with the local installers and AV rental company, to collaborate in the planning phase and to approve the setup and equipment provided. All technical specifications shall be strictly followed by the exhibitor or its agents.

AFA technical advisors will be available for support throughout the exhibit period.

The cost for the rental of the media player and the service of the AFA curator and technical advisor / advisors is available upon request.
